Before installing the tray, plan the route carefully. Identify where the router will be located and mark the path for the tray along walls, ceilings, or under desks. Ensure adequate clearance for airflow and easy access to the router's WAN, LAN, and power ports. Avoid running the tray near heat sources or areas with high moisture to prevent cable damage and interference .

Choosing the Right Cable Tray

Select a tray type that suits your environment:

- Ladder-type trays: Ideal for heavier Ethernet bundles and allow airflow to prevent overheating.
- Perforated trays: Suitable for lighter loads and easier cable entry.

- Solid-bottom trays: Provide extra protection in dusty or industrial areas .

Sizing and Mounting

Calculate the tray width and depth based on the number of cables and their thickness. Undersized trays can cause overheating, while oversized trays waste space. Mount the tray using appropriate clamps and brackets, spacing supports typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart depending on load and tray type. Ensure the tray is level and securely fastened to prevent sagging .

Routing and Securing Cables

Run Ethernet cables (RJ-45) from your modem to the router's WAN port and from the router to other devices via LAN ports. Keep power cables separate from data cables to reduce interference. Use cable ties or Velcro straps to bundle cables neatly, leaving some slack near the router for easy maintenance .

Connecting the Phicomm Router

- Connect the modem to the WAN port on the router using an RJ-45 cable .
- Plug in the router's power adapter and turn it on .
- Configure the router via web interface (192.168.1.1 or 192.168.2.1) or the PhiWiFi app for initial setup, including DHCP, SSID, and password settings .
- Verify that all connected devices receive network access and that the router is functioning properly .

Maintenance Tips

- Periodically check the tray for loose or damaged cables.
- Ensure cables are not overcrowded to maintain airflow and signal integrity.
- Keep the area around the router and tray clean and accessible for troubleshooting or upgrades . By following these steps, you can achieve a safe, organized, and efficient cable management system for your Phicomm wireless router, ensuring reliable network performance and easy maintenance.
