Common Connector Types

- LC (Lucent Connector): Small form factor, push-pull design, widely used in high-density data centers and enterprise networks. Supports duplex and single-mode or multimode fibers .
- SC (Subscriber Connector): Square, snap-in connector, common in PON networks and simpler LAN setups. Easy to install and reliable for single-mode and multimode fibers .

Fiber Modes and Interface Selection

- Single-mode (OS1/OS2): Core $\sim 9\mu\text{m}$, used for long-distance transmission (up to 100 km+). Typically paired with LC, SC, or FC connectors .

- Multimode (OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4/OM5): Core 50–62.5 μm , used for short-distance intra-data center links (up to 500 m). Commonly paired with LC, SC, or MPO connectors .

Applications

- Intra-rack connections: Server NIC to top-of-rack switch, usually LC duplex or MPO breakout .
- Inter-rack connections: Horizontal patching between distribution frames and spine switches, often LC or MPO .
- FTTH/building entry: Indoor-outdoor transition cables connecting outside plant to customer premises, typically SC or LC .
- Test and measurement: Connecting OTDRs, power meters, and light sources to active links, using LC, SC, or FC depending on the equipment .

Key Considerations

- Connector type should match the equipment port and fiber mode.
- Jacket type (PVC, LSZH, OFNP) depends on installation environment and fire safety requirements .
- Insertion loss and return loss are critical for high-speed networks; high-quality connectors with precise end-face polishing (UPC or APC) ensure optimal performance . In summary, LC and MPO connectors dominate modern high-speed networks, while SC, ST, and FC remain relevant in legacy or specialized applications. Choosing the right interface depends on fiber mode, distance, density, and network architecture.
