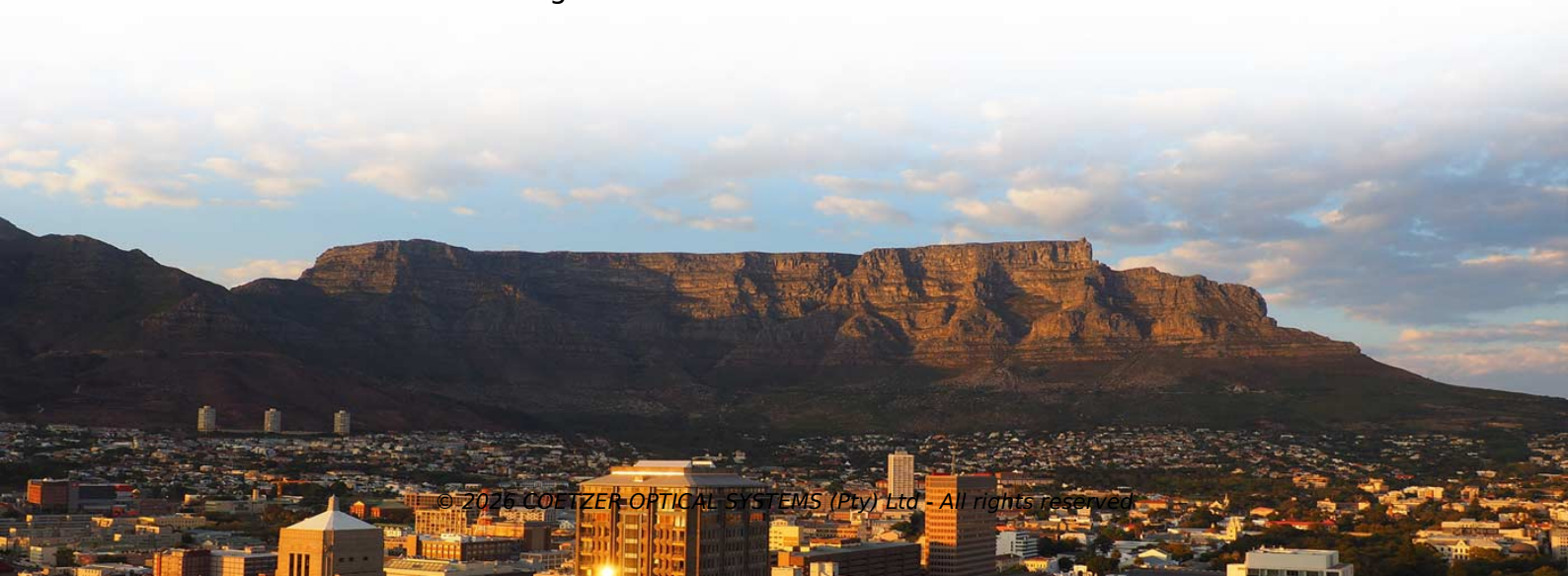

Inside a distribution box, there is usually a grounding bar (PE bar) where the ground wire from the power supply is attached. The connection involves stripping the copper wire, inserting it into the terminal on the PE bar, and tightening the screw to ensure a secure connection. This bar also allows other electrical components within the box to be grounded, providing a safe path for fault currents and preventing electrical hazards (SMICOPower).

Residential Panel Grounding



In residential systems, the main panel serves as the central distribution hub. Here, the neutral bus bar and the ground bus bar are connected at a single point using a bonding jumper. From this junction, a grounding electrode conductor (GEC) runs to a grounding rod or other approved grounding electrode, establishing a zero-voltage reference relative to the earth. This ensures that the ground wire provides a protective path for fault currents and stabilizes system voltage (Engineer Fix ; Science Insights).

Key Points for Safety

- Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire of adequate cross-section for the ground connection.
- Ensure all connections are tight and clearly marked for inspection and maintenance.
- Grounding the distribution box and its components is mandatory for safety and compliance with electrical codes.
- Only one bonding point between neutral and ground should exist to prevent unwanted current flow on grounding conductors (Science Insights). In summary, the ground wire is indeed connected to the distribution box through the PE bar or grounding bus, and this connection is essential for the safe operation of the electrical system, protecting both equipment and occupants from electrical faults.
