Industry standards (NEC, NEMA, IEC) define typical width ranges to ensure compatibility and safe cable fill. The most common nominal widths include:

- 50 mm (2") - Light-duty, small control/data cables
- 75 mm (3") - Light control circuits
- 100 mm (4") - Small installations, control systems
- 150 mm (6") - Light commercial applications
- 200 mm (8") - Medium power distribution
- 225 mm (9") - Moderate cable bundles
- 300 mm (12") - Industrial plants, manufacturing

- 400–450 mm (16–18") – Heavy-duty industrial use
- 600 mm (24") – Large industrial facilities
- 750–1000 mm (30–40") – Very large cable volumes (data centers, factories)

Widths by Cable Tray Type

Different tray types have their own typical width ranges:

- Ladder trays: 6", 9", 12", 18", 24", 30", 36", 42", 48"
- Wire mesh trays: 2" to 24" (e.g., 2, 4, 6, 8, 12, 16, 18, 20, 24)
- Perforated trays: 4" to 36"
- Solid-bottom trays: 4" to 36"
- Channel trays: 1.5" to 6"

International Project Ranges

Global installations often use widths between 50 mm and 900 mm, with depth between 50 mm and 150 mm.

Practical Selection Considerations

- Cable fill requirements (NEC/NEMA guidelines)
- Future expansion (25–30% spare recommended)
- Cable type & bend radius
- Physical space constraints
- Load capacity vs. tray strength
