For ground-mounted distribution boxes, it is recommended to raise the box 2 to 4 inches above the floor to prevent moisture damage and ensure durability (). The box should be located in a dry, well-ventilated area, away from water sources, fire hazards, or areas prone to accidental impacts (). If wall-mounted, the ideal height is 4.5 to 5.5 feet (1.4 to 1.7 meters) for easy access, but for ground-floor installations, the slight elevation above the floor is sufficient ().

Accessibility and Clearance

Ensure the working space in front of the box is clear, with a minimum depth of 3 feet (36 inches) and width of at least 30 inches, allowing safe operation and maintenance (). The panel door should open fully to 90 degrees without obstruction. Vertical clearance should be at least 6.5 feet (≈ 2 meters) to allow personnel to stand upright safely ().

Grounding

Proper grounding is essential. Attach a ground wire from the box's mounting plate to the central grounding point, ensuring the ground resistance is below 0.1 Ohm (). Use the correct wire gauge: 10 AWG in the US or 6 mm² elsewhere. For multiple connected devices, ensure parallel grounding to maintain safe resistance levels ().

Safety and Compliance

- Use UL/CE-certified components and follow local codes such as NEC or IEC standards ().
- Include circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit ().
- Maintain neat wiring, proper insulation, and secure connections ().
- Schedule regular inspections and maintenance to ensure long-term reliability ().
- Label all circuits clearly for easy identification during emergencies ().
