If the router is outdated, underpowered, or improperly configured, it can become a bottleneck, preventing devices from reaching the full speed of your fiber connection .

Common Router-Related Issues

- **Outdated Hardware:** Older routers may not support modern WiFi standards like WiFi 5 (802.11ac) or WiFi 6 (802.11ax), limiting real-world speeds and the number of devices that can be served simultaneously .
- **Undersized WAN Ports:** If your router's WAN port is slower than your fiber plan (e.g., 100 Mbps port with 1 Gbps fiber), it caps your maximum speed .
- **Limited Throughput and Features:** Routers without MU-MIMO or OFDMA struggle to efficiently handle multiple devices, causing slowdowns during heavy usage .

- **Router Placement and Signal Interference:** Physical obstructions, thick walls, or distance from the router can weaken WiFi signals. Nearby networks or multiple WiFi networks in the same home can also interfere .
 - **Firmware and Software:** Outdated router firmware can reduce speed, stability, and security. Regular updates are essential .
 - **Device Limitations:** Even with a capable router, older devices with outdated network cards may not achieve full fiber speeds .

- Upgrade to a modern router that supports WiFi 5 or WiFi 6 and has gigabit or multi-gig WAN ports.
 - Place the router in a central location to minimize signal obstruction.
 - Use Cat 6 or higher Ethernet cables for wired connections to achieve gigabit speeds.
 - Limit network congestion by disconnecting unused devices or using Quality of Service (QoS) settings.
 - Keep router firmware up to date to ensure optimal performance and security. By addressing these router-related factors, you can ensure that your fiber optic internet delivers the speeds promised by your ISP and reduces slowdowns caused by home network limitations .
