Central Processing Unit (CPU): The CPU acts as the control center of the OLT, managing data traffic, coordinating downstream and upstream frames, and executing the Media Access Control (MAC) protocols necessary for communication with connected ONUs/ONTs . **Network/Line Cards:** These cards, sometimes called PON cards, handle the conversion of electrical signals from the service provider's core network into optical signals for transmission over fiber. Each card can support multiple PON ports, allowing connection to numerous ONUs or ONTs . **SFP Modules (Small Form-factor Pluggable):** Many OLTs use SFP modules to interface with fiber optic cables. These modules provide the necessary transmit (Tx) and receive (Rx) wavelengths for optical communication. Not all OLTs require SFPs, but they are common for modular and scalable deployments . **Gateway Router (GWR) and Voice Gateway (VGW) Cards:** These uplink cards connect the OLT to the broader internet or service provider network and manage voice and data traffic, ensuring proper routing and quality of service . **Optical Splitters:** While technically passive and external to the OLT chassis, optical splitters are essential in a PON. They divide the optical signal from a single OLT port to multiple endpoints, supporting split ratios such as 1:32, 1:64, or even 1:128 depending on the PON standard .

Additional Functional Equipment

Downstream and Upstream Frame Processing Units: These handle the conversion of asynchronous transfer mode (ATM) or Ethernet frames into serial optical data for downstream transmission and extract upstream data from incoming optical signals . **Wavelength Division Multiplexing (WDM) Components:** Some OLTs include WDM modules to combine multiple wavelengths on a single fiber, enabling simultaneous transmission of downstream and upstream signals . **Control Signal Generation Units:** These generate timing and control signals for coordinating data flow, ensuring proper synchronization between the OLT and connected ONUs/ONTs .
