A fiber optic patch cord, also called a fiber jumper, is a cable with connectors on both ends used to transmit optical signals between devices. The core of the patch cord consists of one or two optical fibers. In the case of a duplex patch cord, which is the most common type, there are two fibers: one for transmitting light (sending) and one for receiving light (receiving), enabling bidirectional communication. Each fiber is made of a glass core surrounded by cladding, which guides the light, and is protected by a buffer coating and an outer jacket for mechanical strength.

Simplex vs Duplex

- Simplex patch cord: Contains a single fiber for one-way transmission.
- Duplex patch cord: Contains two fibers, allowing simultaneous two-way communication. The fibers may be housed in a single jacket or as two separate cables joined together, often referred to as a "zip cord".

Additional Protection

The fibers are often reinforced with Kevlar yarn or other strength members to prevent damage during handling, and the outer jacket provides flexibility and protection . The connectors at each end, such as LC, SC, or MPO, terminate the fibers and allow easy connection to network devices. In summary, the two wires in a standard duplex fiber optic patch cord are the transmit fiber and the receive fiber, which together enable bidirectional optical communication between devices .
